



Code of Conduct: Parents

1. I will not force my child to participate in soccer.
2. I will remember that my child plays soccer for his or her enjoyment, not for mine.
3. I will encourage my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
4. I will teach my child that doing one's best is as important as winning so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game.
5. I will make my child feel like a winner every time by offering praise for competing fairly and doing their best
6. I will never ridicule or yell at my child or anybody else child for making a mistake or losing a game.
7. I will applaud good plays/performances by both my child's team and their opponents.
8. I will never question the referee's judgment or honesty
9. I will respect and show appreciation for the volunteer coaches who give their time to coach soccer for the benefit of my child.
10. I will avoid coaching players from the sidelines during games and only offer words of positive encouragement before, during and after the game.
11. I will avoid any altercations, physical or verbal abuse with fellow team parents or parents of the opposing team or the refs or any of the coaching staff.
