Frequently Asked Questions.....and answers!

Question: What division is my son or daughter registered in?

Answer: The following are the divisions and the year of birth that is applicable

Q: Why are the divisions for boys and girls different?

A. In order to offer sufficient numbers of teams, the girls divisions are combined for two age levels (i.e. U9 is comprised of players born in 2001 and 2002). For U18 we have combined players born 1994, 1993 and 1992 to accommodate all those players wishing to play. We did not receive sufficient registrations to offer house league soccer to boys born in 1992 and 1993. .

Q: When will house league start?

- A. The first games will commence the week of May 31, 2010. Coaches will be receiving their team lists in a series of meetings from May 28 – May 30, so they may NOT BE ABLE TO CALL YOU BEFORE THEN.
- B. You can expect to receive a call anytime from May 28 to May 31 and expect that you will have your first game that week, in accordance with the schedule of playing nights that were indicated when you registered.

Q: What do I need to play house league soccer?

A: All players **MUST** wear soccer shin guards when playing or practicing. They can be purchased at most sports and department stores. Soccer shoes are recommended. You will receive socks, shorts and a uniform from your coach at your first game or practice.

Q: I asked to be placed on a specific team with a friend. Will that happen?

A: The short answer is probably not. We try to put together balanced teams in our house league and other than sponsors and coaches' children being placed on specific teams, we cannot accommodate these type of requests in order to ensure our house league is enjoyable for all. .

Q: Something has changed since I registered and my child cannot play this summer. What do I do?

A: You must come into the clubhouse in person and fill out a request for refund form. In most cases, a \$25 administration fee will be charged. Payment is usually processed in a couple of weeks. **The deadline for refund requests is May 27, 2010.** .
